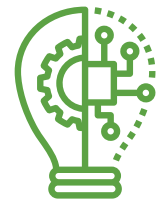

The Rutherford Works High School Internship Program provides Rutherford County High School students the opportunity to gain work-based learning experience through part-time jobs with employers from Eagleville, La Vergne, Murfreesboro, and Smyrna.

Students gain job exposure within a selected career field and begin to develop soft skills, hard skills and industry specific knowledge to prepare them for a successful career in the workplace.



During this paid high school internship, students are given the opportunity to job shadow, network, gain hands-on experience and build their high school resume for college whether they are planning to attend a technical college, community college or four-year university. Students also receive training and information related to early-post secondary opportunities, college application requirements and college scholarships.
