JOB OUTLOOK

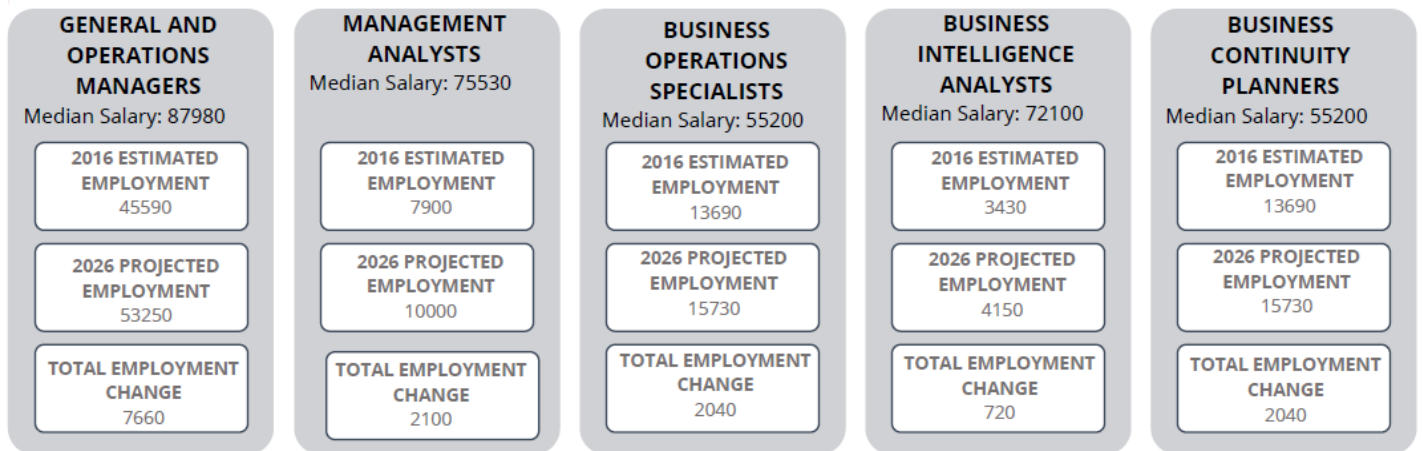
